### Information released:

*Q1. The amount of public funding that each SSC received from the UKCES or SSDA in every year since 2002, up to and including 2009*

A1. Attached is an excel spreadsheet detailing the amount of funding received as per your question. Please note that we no longer hold information from SSDA dating back from 2002. The figures outlined in the document begin at 2003/04. The figures enclosed includes core funding as well as project funding for discrete deliverables.

*Q2. The amount of private funding that each SCC raised from 2002 to 2009 inclusive*

A2. The UK Commission is not able to provide information about private funding to sub-contractors. Due to the diverse nature of the Sector Skills Councils in terms of the organisational design, nature in terms of private or public sector, and legislative powers to draw income from the specific sector the information may vary greatly, however, Statutory Accounts for many of the SSCs can be accessed via Companies House (<http://www.companieshouse.gov.uk/>) and may provide you with the detail pertaining to the source and flow of funding for the organisations.

*Q3. The planned public funding each SSC will receive from 2010 to 2012 inclusive*

A3. The funding for 2010 to 2012 is not fully allocated yet so wouldn't give a comparable picture to previous years.
