As part of our objectives for this work will be to develop a clearer internal position on brand licensing. This work will inform thinking around the types of organisations we license products from. Any final licensing decisions will be made in the interests of furthering the wider Investors in People mission. Therefore, it is likely that licensed organisations will deliver services that link closely with our core purpose. The rationale for licensing other organisations, as opposed to UKCES delivering products directly, is that delivery is likely to go beyond UKCES core competencies and resources as a business. We have ambitious plans for Investors in People but currently lack the internal capacity to deliver at scale for our customers. |
